
ELIZABETH GURLEY FLYNN



Rebel Girl chronicles the fiery romance between the labor activist Elizabeth Gurley Flynn and Italian revolutionary Carlo Tresca against a backdrop of early 20th Century American social unrest. Along with birth control visionary Margaret Sanger, radical songwriter Joe Hill and other members of the International Workers of the World (The Wobblies) they battle for social and economic equality and challenge the power of industrialists like John D. Rockefeller and Federal Security services led by a young J. Edgar Hoover.

World War I, The Tulsa Race Massacre, Industrial violence, and the first Red Scare cast a long shadow over their fight. Although Rebel Girl is set in a unique time, it closely resembles present-day America with its immigration issues, income inequality, racial unease, and partisan divide. The characters, all historical figures, helped create modern U.S. democracy. Rebel Girl sets them free once more to tell their remarkable American story.

Chilina Kennedy

Chilina Kennedy played Carole King in Beautiful on Broadway She recently appeared as Myrtle in The Great Gatsby and originated the role of Dina in the Broadway national tour of The Band's Visit. Other Broadway credits include Jesus Christ Superstar and A Gentleman's Guide to Love and Murder. Canadian credits include leading roles at the Stratford and Shaw Festivals. As a composer, she released the album What You Find in a Bottle and co-wrote the musical Wild About You.

Miguel Cervantes is an actor and singer. He played Alexander Hamilton in Hamilton, first in Chicago and later on Broadway. His stage credits include American Idiot and If/Then, and he has appeared on screen in Madam Secretary, Person of Interest, and The Blacklist. Cervantes was named Chicago Tribune's "Chicagoan of the Year in Theater"

Van Hughes

Van's Broadway credits include American Idiot, Spring Awakening, 9 to 5, and Hairspray. His screen work includes Sex and the City, Rachel Getting Married, and Law & Order: SVU. As a composer, he scored the film Sequence Break and performs with the Brooklyn synth-pop band Teen Commandments.

Becca Suskauer

Becca Suskauer recently originated the role of Kendra in Relapse: A New Musical Off-Broadway and appeared in the national tour of Pretty Woman. Regional credits include The Muny and New London Barn Playhouse. In NYC, she has performed at 54 Below, Rockwood Music Hall, & Carnegie Hall. Becca is a graduate of Penn State's BFA Musical Theatre program.

Katie Thompson

On Broadway, Katie created the role of Aunt Eller in Oklahoma! She has originated roles in Renascence, Big Fish, and Giant. She also wrote music and lyrics for R.R.R.E.D.. As a songwriter, her work has been featured at Lincoln Center, 54 Below, and on So You Think You Can Dance. Thompson has released several solo albums and contributed to recordings by contemporary composers.
